**A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK**

Ugh!! As I write this we are expecting another snow storm this weekend – the third one in a row! Truly, I hate it when these storms prevent people from getting to weekend mass. It really makes a difference. I hope that when this happens that you are able to take some time, read the scriptures, pray (perhaps even see mass on TV) and know that you are still connected to the community. I know I look forward to community prayer, and miss it when it doesn't happen.

Beginning next week you will see a change in the way the Offertory Collection is taken up at mass. We will be moving to a system of hand-passed baskets, as opposed to the more familiar usher-passed basket. Now, the ushers will simply hand a basket to someone at various locations in the church. We ask you to deposit your offering, then pass the basket along that row, and then to the row behind you etc. Then, the ushers will pick up the basket from you.

This manner of collecting acknowledges the many people who now donate on-line, or mail a check once a month, and allows them to simply move the basket along without feeling pressured to donate something else. Thank you for all that you do.

Lastly, next weekend we begin the 2013 Catholic Appeal. This year our goal is \$49,485.00 You should already have received your request letter from the Archdiocese. Please use the return envelope to mail in your donation, or you may drop it in the weekend collection and we will mail it for you. Please remember that this represents a bill to the parish, and we must make our goal, or make up the difference. Thank you for your customary generosity.

**A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTORAL ASSOCIATE'S DESK**

Last month I asked for volunteers to help with baking cookies for the Harvard Square Meals Program. From the Christmas giving tree and other food drives I knew the people of St. Peter's act with generosity. Cookie baking, however, would take a bit of time and we needed a large quantity of cookies. (I did have visions of staying up the night before and transforming my kitchen into the Keebler kitchen.) Nevertheless, before the bulletin even went to print (the online edition comes up a day or two before the print one) I had parishioners call and email to volunteer. These calls were steady and we achieved the promise of 25 dozen in no time. Two days before the cookies were to be delivered I got additional calls and emails asking if we needed more cookies – I think we could have come up with many more dozens. Dessert is a small part of a meal, some think of it as the best part – I am proud to be a part of a community that can come together and bring their best part to the table.

I heard from the coordinators and the cookies were a hit. They thanked us publicly at the beginning of the meal in their words of welcome to their guests. I have been asked by parishioners if we are going to reach out similarly again. We are currently looking into ways that St. Peter's can continue to support the very important work the Harvard Square Meals program does in our community on Thursday nights.
