Some of you may have heard me read this letter last weekend. It was received last week in the mail from a gentleman who lives in New Jersey, and underscores the power we have to witness to our faith as we go about our daily, routine lives.

Dear F. O'Malley,

My wife and I, plus my daughter and her husband traveled to Boston Easter Weekend to see my grandson, a member of Duke's lacrosse team, compete Saturday night against Harvard's lacrosse team. It was truly an exciting game right down to the last 8 seconds as the final score: Duke 12, Harvard 11 will testify. Happy for us; maybe not so happy for you.

But that is not why I am writing this letter to you. My wife and I plus my daughter and son-in-law came to St. Peter Church on Sunday for the 8:00 AM Easter Mass. All of us felt that this mass was perhaps one of the most beautiful and inspiring masses that we have ever attended. To begin with, the church bulletin's profound open arms welcoming message reminded me of the encircling all-embracing colonnades as you approach St. Peter's in Rome.
