Please remember that we have a TOWN HALL MEETING this Sunday afternoon from 3:30 – 4:45 PM in the Parish Center. This is the third in our series of meetings around the topic of Pastoral Planning.

As you know, the **proposal** that we have before us would have Saint Peter and Saint John Parishes, Cambridge being served by one Pastoral Service Team, but maintaining their own separate identities and responsibilities. This type of approach is an attempt to strengthen parishes at a time of diminishing participation in church life, and diminishing numbers of priests to serve the parishes of the Archdiocese. When we look at the facts it is abundantly clear that something has to be done. One of the questions before us is: Does this plan present us with an opportunity for success in strengthening our parishes and being more involved in the Mission of the Church?

We will briefly review the need for some type of plan, the proposal itself, and attempt to answer questions people may have. Your comments and thoughts will then be forwarded to the Archdiocesan Planning Commission. They will be meeting over the summer months, so that they can present a comprehensive proposal to the Cardinal for implementation in the Archdiocese.

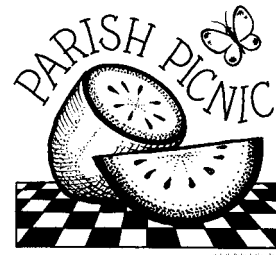
