PASTORAL PLANNING UPDATE.

There was an interesting article in last week's edition of The Pilot, in which Fr. Paul Soper, Interim Director of the Pastoral Planning Commission was interviewed. In it we learned several pieces of new information, which I now pass along to you.

After revising the proposal (as reported in a June parish bulletin) the Commission expects to present the proposal to Cardinal O'Malley by the end of this month.

If the Cardinal accepts the proposal, "sometime in the middle of 2013 we would establish the first 10 collaboratives...two in each of the five regions of the Archdiocese."

Learning from these, and having provided additional training to Pastoral Service Teams, "maybe something like 40 collaboratives would come on in the summer of 2014. That phase would probably last for two years."

"Then maybe in the summer of 2016 another 40 and then again, perhaps in the summer of 2017 or even as late as 2018, the rest of the collaboratives."

"It's spread out, from the time the first collaborative comes on to the time of the last it could be as much as five years; but the whole thing, from the beginning of the training to the end of the last step is more like seven years."

Once again, this is what the Planning Commission is proposing. Everything is dependant on Cardinal O'Malley accepting the proposal and implementing it, either as is, or with changes.

Rev. Bernard Taylor of The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette will preach this weekend for the annual parish mission appeal.

Having brought the fullness of Life to our world when He rose from the dead, Jesus sent his disciples to share this life with all of creation. *"They went forth and preached everywhere"* (Mk 16:20). The Missionaries of Our Lady of La Salette minister to people of every race, language, culture and way of life - beginning at the La Salette Shrine in France where our Blessed Mother appeared in 1846. Her final words, *"Well, my children, you will make this known to all my people,"* echo Jesus' Gospel mandate. It is little wonder that the La Salette congregation has always been mission orientated.
