There was an interesting article in August 10th's edition of The Pilot, in which Fr. Paul Soper, Interim Director of the Pastoral Planning Commission was interviewed. In it we learned several pieces of new information, which I now pass along to you.

After revising the proposal (as reported in a June parish bulletin) the Commission expects to present the proposal to Cardinal O'Malley by the end of this month.

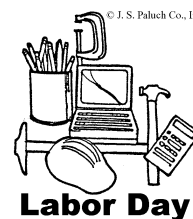
If the Cardinal accepts the proposal, "sometime in the middle of 2013 we would establish the first 10 collaboratives...two in each of the five regions of the Archdiocese."

Learning from these, and having provided additional training to Pastoral Service Teams, "maybe something like 40 collaboratives would come on in the summer of 2014. That phase would probably last for two years."

"Then maybe in the summer of 2016 another 40 and then again, perhaps in the summer of 2017 or even as late as 2018, the rest of the collaboratives."

"It's spread out, from the time the first collaborative comes on to the time of the last it could be as much as five years; but the whole thing, from the beginning of the training to the end of the last step is more like seven years."

Once again, this is what the Planning Commission is proposing. Everything is dependant on Cardinal O'Malley accepting the proposal and implementing it, either as is, or with changes.

#### **Youth Parish Choir**

All youth in grades 1 and up who enjoy singing are invited to join the Youth Choir. The Youth Choir is all about giving the youth of our parish the words of joy, praise and love, through song so they can grow closer to the Lord. It also allows the youth a chance to participate in worship and minister to others through their music. The choir provides musical leadership at the Sunday, 10:00 A.M. Mass, from September to June, starting on September 16, 2012. Rehearsals are before the 10:00 A.M. Mass on Sunday, starting at 9:15 A.M.

#### **Adult Parish Choirs**

The Adult Parish Choirs provide musical leadership during two liturgies on the weekend, as well as major Solemnities and Feast Days. The choirs are a diverse and friendly community of volunteer musicians. The choir provides a great opportunity to develop vocal and musical skills, and to enhance your singing abilities. Membership is open to all singers, high school age and up.

*The Traditional Choir* provides musical leadership at the Saturday, 4:00 P.M. Mass from September to June, starting on September 8, 2012. Rehearsals are before the 4:00 P.M. Mass on Saturday starting at 3:00 P.M.

*The Contemporary Choir* provides musical leadership at the Sunday, 5:00 P.M. Mass. This is a year round choir. Rehearsals are before the 5:00 P.M. Mass on Sunday starting at 4:00 P.M.

*Seasonal Choir* is a combination of both adult choirs and for those who would like to participate in music ministry for the liturgical Celebrations of Christmas and Easter.

**Christmas** The choir provides musical leadership at the 4:00 P.M. Mass on Christmas Eve, December 24<sup>th</sup>. Rehearsals for Christmas will be held on Wednesday evenings, November 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>, December 5<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 19<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 P.M. to 9:30 P.M. in the church.

**Easter** The choir provides musical leadership during the celebration of Holy Week at the 4:00 P.M. Mass Saturday, March 24<sup>th</sup> for Palm Sunday, March 28<sup>th</sup> Holy Thursday, and March 30<sup>th</sup> Holy Saturday. Rehearsals for the Triduum will be held on Wednesday evenings, February 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, 27<sup>th</sup>, March 6<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, and 27<sup>th</sup>.



## Religious Education Registration 2012 - 2013

### Grades K - 5

Registration for Grades K - 5 for St. Peter Parish Religious Education Program will take place in the Parish Center on Sunday, September 16th immediately following the 10:00 am Family Liturgy. For students who will be receiving the Sacrament of First Eucharist this year and **were not baptized** at St. Peter Parish, parents are asked to bring a copy of their child's baptismal certificate to registration on Sept. 16th. For children who were baptized here at St. Peter's, parents are asked to let us know the month and year of the child's baptism.

Preparation for First Eucharist is considered a two year program (Grades 1 & 2). It is expected that Grade 2 students have participated in a Grade 1 religious education class. Classes for all K-5 students will meet on Sundays after the 10:00 am Mass from 11:15 - 12:15 in the school.

Tuition for Religious Education is \$30 per student and \$50 for a family. Classes begin on September 23rd.

### Middle School and Confirmation Religious Education Information

Registration for Middle School (grades 6-8) and Confirmation (grades 9&10) will take place on Sunday, September 16th immediately following the 10:00 am Mass in the Parish Center.

The Middle School program will meet on Sunday evenings from 6:00 - 7:15 pm approximately once a month. A more detailed description of the program and a calendar of meetings will be available at registration. The program begins on September 30th.

The Confirmation program is a two year program. Typically, this coincides with 9th and 10th grade. All students, including students enrolled at Catholic High Schools, need to participate in both years. The program consists of four areas: Liturgical, required attendance at Mass; Community Service; Spiritual, required participation in retreats and Educational, required monthly meetings along with a Confirmation sponsor or parent (please note if the student is enrolled in a Catholic High School he/she does not need to attend the sessions in the first year of the program but is required to do so in the second year). A full description of the program will be available at registration. Please bring a copy of the child's baptismal certificate if the child was not baptized at St. Peter's.
