To that end, the Pastoral Council and Finance Council members will be attending a consultation meeting on March 1<sup>st</sup>. This meeting is set up for Council Members to be informed and then have the opportunity to respond directly to members of the Planning Commission about any concerns they have with the planning proposal. They, then, will bring us questions and information from the Planning Commission so that all parishioners are included in the planning initiative.

To this end, we are scheduling another opportunity for parishioners to gather. This time we will schedule Sunday morning, March 4<sup>th</sup> at 11:15 AM for interested people to gather. This Town Hall type meeting will take place after the Family Mass, in the School Cafeteria. Refreshments will be served.

Soon there will be consultations with the Planning Committee of the Archdiocese scheduled for parishioners. This will be your opportunity to speak your mind directly to the Planning Committee. Your opinion is important. We will let you know dates as soon as they are published.
