A very blessed, happy and healthy New Year to all of you! We will continue to pray for all of our families throughout this season.

And, a very sincere Thank You for your great generosity in the Giving Tree project this year, in the Food Collection, and for your thoughtfulness to me and to the Staff during this time.

Thank you also for your generosity in the 2011 Grand Annual Collection. We are almost at our goal of \$150,000. Let me make a last plea. Our total so far represents donations from 24% of registered parishioners (including very large gifts from 3 parish families). Imagine what we would be able to accomplish if 100% of our parish were to participate in some way. I keep saying (and I mean it) the size of the donation is not what speaks best of the love that people have for Saint Peter Parish. The participation level speaks volumes, however, of our common desire for the continued success and life of the parish. I know for sure that 100% of our parish families care deeply for Saint Peter's.
