Boston Catholic Appeal 2012

As we celebrate the joyful sacraments of the season, we are reminded of many aspects of parish life that strengthen our families. Your generous support of the Catholic Appeal helps sustain the sacramental and temporal life in our parish.

This year our parish money goal is \$50,275 and our parish participation goal is 98 families/households. This goal is attainable if all parishioners will share responsibility by making a donation. **Please know that, unlike previous years, this amount is now a bill to the parish. If we do not collect this amount, we will have to make it up from parish funds.** If you did not receive an envelope in the mail, additional envelopes are available at all the doors of the church. Returns may be mailed directly to the Appeal Office. As of May 11th 63 families from St. Peter Parish have donated \$30,355. This represents 60% of our goal of \$50,275.

In the Gospel this Sunday, Jesus prays that we may be one as He is one with God the Father, so that we may know and experience the true and complete joy of God. When we help those who need us, we become more fully united to them.
