This weekend, at the Announcement Time, after Communion, I will be speaking at all of the masses. We are looking to bring our Increased Offertory Campaign to a close by next weekend when we ask people to make a declaration of their intentions of weekly/monthly support of Saint Peter Parish. Part of the purpose in asking for this declaration is that we be better able to construct a realistic parish budget for the year. We aim to make the budget reflect more accurately what we, the parishioners of Saint Peter Parish will commit to supporting. Presently our regular weekly/monthly income supports only about one-third of our current operating expenses. We need to seriously reduce our reliance of "extra" income (rent and gifts). We need to identify what we can fully depend on, and thus take ownership of our own parish life.

We are the inheritors of the gift of Saint Peter Parish that prior generations have built and provided for us. We need to continue this proud tradition and insure that we and generations to come will continue to enjoy and benefit from the life of faith that is shared and deepened in this community of faith under the patronage of Saint Peter.

We do ask you to prayerfully consider your response to this appeal – whatever you are able to do – and to make your decision known by Sunday, October 21st. You may either return your pledge card at any mass that weekend, or mail it to the parish office.

If you have seen this material in the bulletin and are not presently a registered member of the parish – or if you're a sometime visitor to the parish – we also encourage you to consider the importance of your donation also. We promote a Stewardship approach (sharing of time, talent and treasure) to parish life. This stands in direct opposition to a Consumerist approach (I pay for what I use when I'm here).
