Proposal to Cardinal Seán –**

The Archdiocesan Pastoral Planning Commission (APPC) recently completed 2 years of consultation and has made a proposal to Cardinal Seán to strengthen parishes for evangelization and to enhance our efforts of faith formation and outreach across the archdiocese. Cardinal Seán is in the process of receiving input from archdiocesan councils until early November. Increased Offertory Campaign:

This coming week all registered parishioners will be receiving a request letter to respond to our appeal to raise our regular weekly/monthly income. We ask you to prayerfully consider your request and respond with a generous heart. We will ask that all commitments be made by October 21st when this campaign ends.

Over the last five years, the cost of living index has risen 11.16% and the offertory collection of the parish has risen only 4.38%. As we look to the future, it is clear that we need to raise our regular, planned income. This will allow us to establish true, workable budgets that will care for our immediate needs as well as provide for future needs as well.

Last weekend we published the facilities report from this past summer, with costs of each project included. This weekend, both the bulletin and web site show the parish financial statement (Financial Year ending 6/30/12). Next week both the web site and the bulletin will have the parish budget for this fiscal year. We want you to understand the financial picture of the parish. Please note also, this campaign speaks only of the regular, planned (offertory) income of the parish.

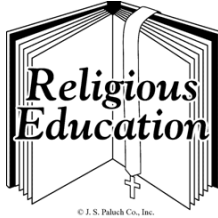
Please note that the item marked "subsidy to school" is actually the exact amount of rent received from the cell tower rental of our steeple and is included in the income section under lease income.

Confirmation Preparation Program Begins September 23rd

Confirmation preparation is a two year program (typically coinciding with 9th and 10th grades). The program is comprised of four areas: liturgical, spiritual, service and educational. All students must complete all areas in both years (*Catholic school students need to register and participate for two years, special consideration is given towards the educational component only in the first year*). Registration for K-5 is ongoing in the school cafeteria after 10:00 am Mass.

Classes begin this weekend September 23rd after the 10:00 am Mass in the parish school for grades K-5. For students who will be receiving the Sacrament of First Eucharist this year and were not baptized at St. Peter Parish, parents are asked to attach a copy of child's baptismal certificate to their registration form. For children who were baptized here at St. Peter's, parents are asked to let us know the month and year of the child's baptism.

Preparation for First Eucharist is considered a two year program (Grades 1 & 2). It is expected that Grade 2 students have participated in a Grade 1 religious education class. Classes for all K-5 students will meet on Sundays after the 10:00 Mass from 11:15-12:15 in the school.

Tuition for Religious Education is \$30 per student and \$50 for a family.

Middle School Religious Education Program Begins on September 30th:

The Middle School (grades 6-8) Religious Education program will meet on Sunday evenings from 6:00 - 7:15 pm approximately once a month. We are using a curriculum program based on a three year cycle. Thus, each student is exposed to each subject area over a three year period. A more detailed description of the program and a calendar of meetings will be available upon registration.
