EASTER SEASON HAPPENINGS:

Congratulations again to all the candidates who received the sacrament of Confirmation last weekend. Also, thanks to sponsors, families, staff members, Bishop Hennessey and all of the faith community for helping these candidates during this part of their faith journeys.

Congratulations also to Rodney Marable who was received into the life of the Church last weekend, confirmed in the Spirit and received Eucharist for the first time.

The Pastoral Council would like to thank all those who have either attended one of the Town Hall meetings or have commented on the proposed plan for collaboration among parishes in the Archdiocese – specifically, for us, Saint Peter and Saint John Parishes. We are now in the process of formulating a response to the Planning Commission. We will be happy to share this with you when it is completed. (Parish responses are due to the Planning Commission by May 1st. They will then attempt to formulate a final proposal to submit to the Cardinal for his consideration.)

Facilities Corner:

In our last facility update we spoke of going Green with investments in equipment to burn natural gas. Between the mild winter and the conversion to gas we have been able to save over \$15,000.00 this year alone.

Now we have gone **Digital.**

Starting seven years ago when we had to repair many of the drains on the property we laid conduit to interconnect all the buildings on the property for future telecommunications needs. We also separated the electrical service from the Convent to the Rectory to allow us to lease out the Convent with separated utilities.

During the past two years we have been working with Comcast to switch the property from analog services to Digital. Last week we completed this task. We were able to negotiate with the company to install state of the art services on the property at no cost to the Parish. This included removal of all the dangerous and unsightly wires hanging over the play areas of the school.

We now have the highest speed services available to the **Hoff Technology Center** in the school. We also have Business/School class Cable TV services and all phone lines have been switched to Comcast. The Parish Web site **www.saintpetercambridge.org** continues to be upgraded during this process. We have also added **Constant Contact** technology services which allow us to keep the entire school and parish informed through efficient and safe Internet notices. To continue this process make sure the office has your current e-mail!

There are many advantages to the move to Digital services. The biggest is the estimated annual savings of over \$4,000.00 per year in phone costs alone.

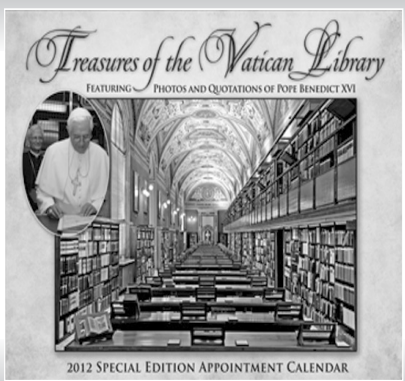
