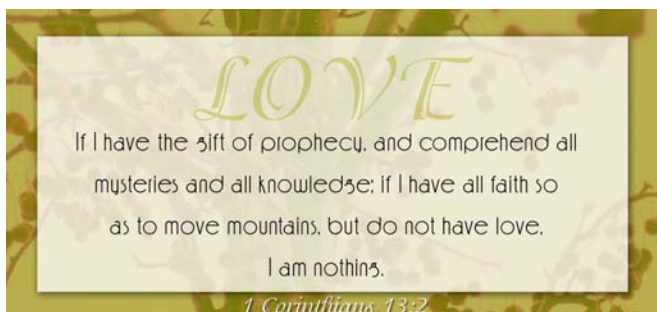

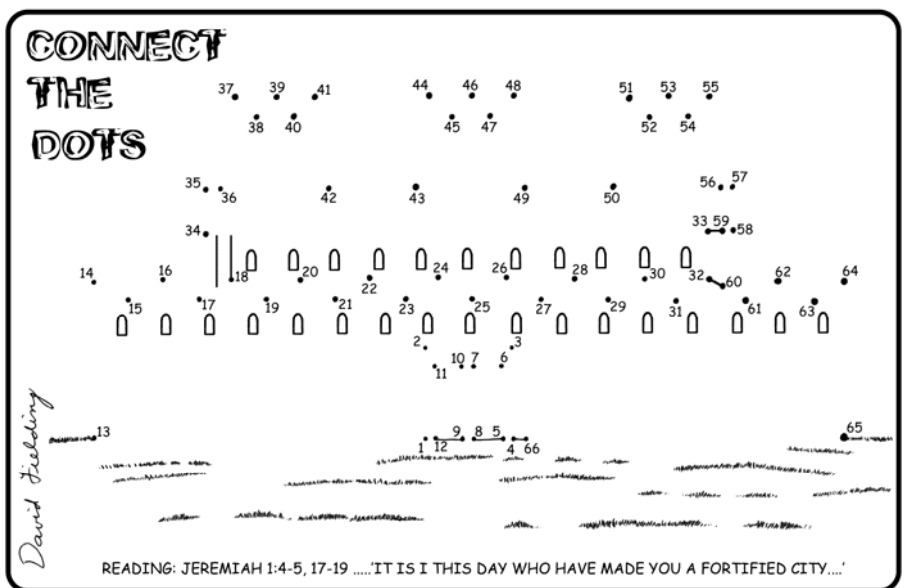
***10<sup>th</sup> Annual Dare to Dream Auction***

The Harvard Square Churches Meal Program began in 1982 as an ecumenical ministry in Harvard Square. It serves a nutritious sit down dinner every Thursday night at Christ Church to over 120 people each week. It takes many dedicated volunteers and donations to provide a healthy meal each week.

Our initiative this month is to provide the program with the dessert portion of the meal for one meal on Thursday, February 7<sup>th</sup>. Together, we hope to provide 300 chocolate chip cookies for one dinner. Please consider making one or two dozen cookies – we need 25 dozen to make this work!
