The Harvard Square Churches Meal Program began in 1982 as an ecumenical ministry of ten churches in Harvard Square. It serves a nutritious sit-down dinner every Thursday at Christ Church at 0 Garden Street to over 120 people. The program attracts many college students to help set up, serve and clean up the meal. In the summer months, as the college students leave the area, their need for help is greater.

We are hoping St. Peter Parish can help fill this gap this summer. Beginning on Thursday June 20th, please plan to join us in the parish center at 5pm (we can park here and walk down). Their doors open for guests at 5:30 and dinner is served at 6 pm. Clean up is 7-7:30.



Summer Book and Movie Discussion
