## Catholic Appeal Update

As of March 26, 2014, parishioners have contributed \$30,575 to this Appeal. This comes from 47 donors. This is a very important collection for the Archdiocese. Arthur Calter grew up in Brookline and was 1 of 3 in his family to become a priest! He served in parishes in Marlborough, Salem, Needham and Braintree. The Vietnam War called Fr. Art to bring the presence of Christ to so many young men serving in the trenches. As an Army Chaplain, he was embedded with infantrymen and marines in the jungle, where he would celebrate up to 12 Masses a day! He later ministered in another battlefield—St. Augustine's in South Boston during the busing crisis. After 5 decades of faithful ministry, Fr.
