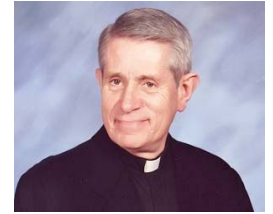

A warm welcome to all who are visiting us this Palm Sunday! This week begins the celebration of Holy Week. These are among the most beautiful celebrations of the church year. We encourage all to participate in these beautiful liturgies!



Holy Thursday service of the Lord's Supper also includes the Washing of Feet. In response to Jesus' command to "do this in memory of me" we celebrate the Supper of the Lord and Wash Each Other's Feet. This service is about one hour and thirty minutes long.

Good Friday service of the Passion of the Lord includes the sung Gospel and the Veneration of the Cross. This service is about one hour and thirty minutes long.

The Easter Vigil is the grand celebration of Light, Word, Water and Eucharist. This year it includes the welcoming of two new members to the life of the church. This service is usually just over two hours long.

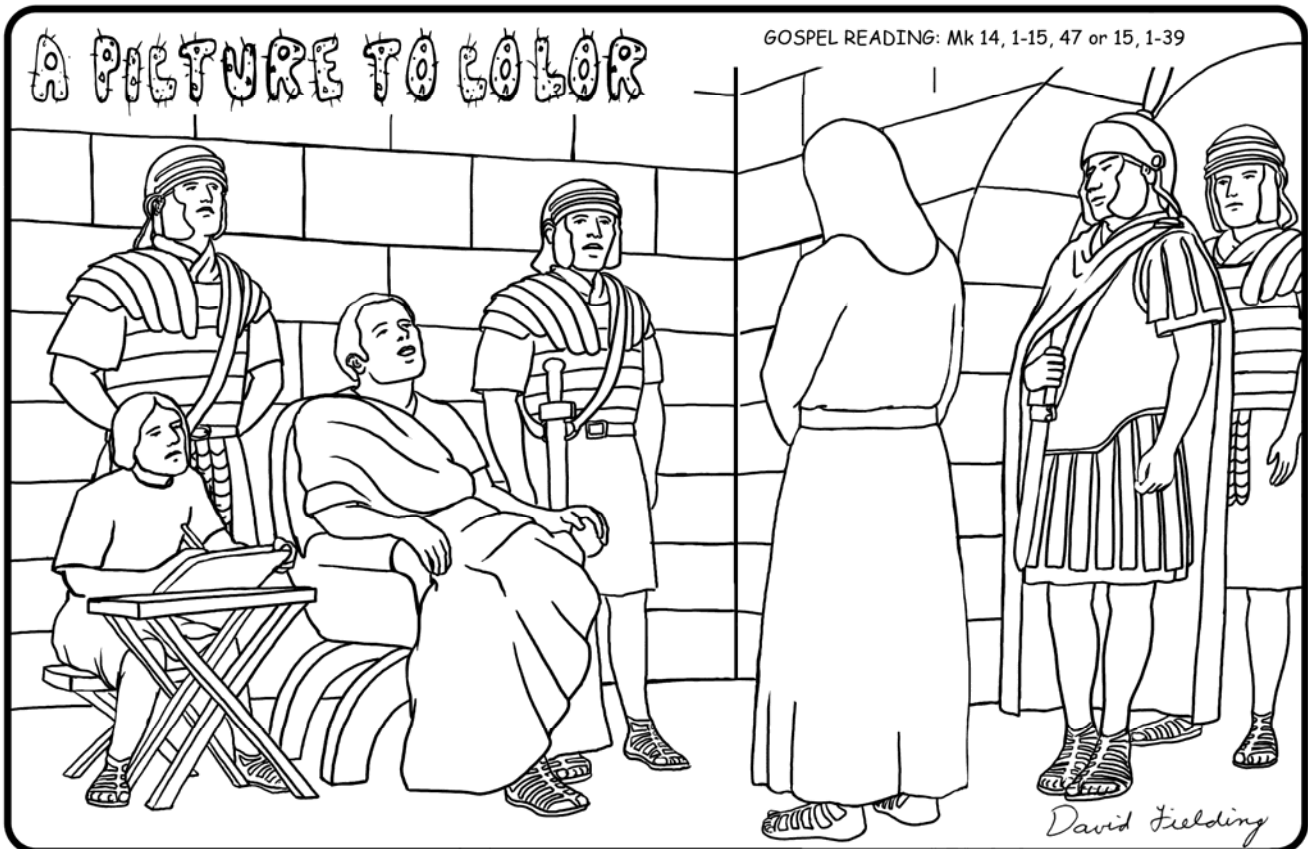
