A MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

With the onset of winter weather – and cold and flu season – a gentle reminder to take care and exercise good judgment in the reception of holy communion.

The reception of communion in the life of the church, is offered both in the form of consecrated bread and wine – and we will continue to do so. Please consider taking the consecrated bread in your hand when receiving, and, of course, if you are not feeling well, make a prudent decision on receiving the consecrated wine from the chalice.

All of our Eucharistic ministers will be using hand sanitizer prior to distributing communion. A little thought and effort on all of our parts is greatly appreciated.

Also, next weekend we celebrate the beginning of Catholic School Week 2013. We will open Catholic Schools Week next Sunday with the school community joining the parish community at our Family Mass at 10:00 AM. School events will continue throughout the week.

The fact that Saint Peter Parish hosts and supports a catholic school (the last one in Cambridge!) is both a great blessing and a challenge for us. Saint Peter School is known locally and throughout the Archdiocese as a premier example of the excellence of catholic education. We are very grateful for all those who support our school.

Small Faith Sharing Groups at St. Peter Parish

Did you know that there are presently two on-going small faith groups that meet monthly at St. Peter Parish?

What are small faith sharing groups?

Small faith sharing groups gather to pray, reflect on scripture and share faith with other members of the group. Ideally, these groups have between 6-10 participants which meet monthly. These groups foster a sense of community both within the group and in the larger parish. A typical meeting is about an hour and a half and includes prayer and discussion.

One of our groups started after the parish *ARISE* program, the other started after the *Why Catholic?* program. Participation in this type of group allows one the ability to reflect on where they see God working in their lives; the opportunity to get to know other people in the parish; and the occasion to pray for and with others.

Do you think you may be interested in this type of opportunity? We are currently looking into establishing a third small faith sharing group this winter at St. Peter's.
