


### Memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne Parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary Saturday July 26th

It serves a nutritious sit-down dinner to over 120 people every Thursday at Christ Church, Zero Garden Street. The program attracts many college students to help set up, serve and clean up the meal. In the summer months, as the college students leave the area, the program’s need for help is greater.



We are hoping St. Peter Parish can help fill this gap of volunteers this summer, every Thursday from June 5<sup>th</sup> through August 28<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers need to arrive between 5-5:15 p.m. The church doors open for guests at 5:30 and dinner is served at 6:00 p.m. Clean up is 7-7:30 p.m. Only eight volunteers are needed each week. 
