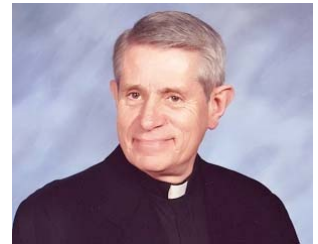
## From the Pastor's Desk

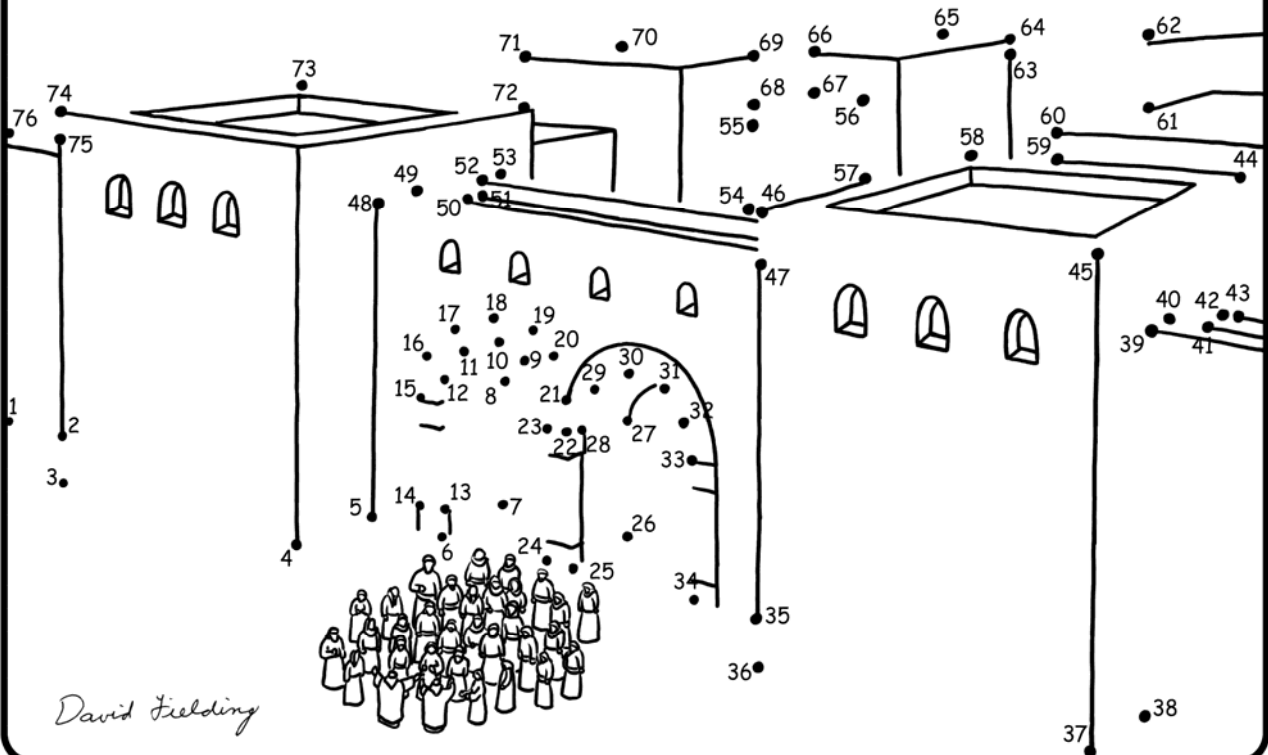
