FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:

It's been quite a while now, so I would like to update you on the Archdiocesan implementation of *Disciples in Mission* – the establishment of parish collaboratives. In this plan all parishes remain independent parishes, but a collaborative (1,2 or 3 parishes) is served by one Pastoral Service Team (pastor, pastoral associate, director of faith formation, liturgical director, deacon, business manager etc.).

Phase One began this past June, and involved 12 collaboratives (28 different parishes). Phase Two has been announced and will establish 21 more collaboratives (44 parishes participating). The pastor/priest assignments to these new groupings will be announced around Christmas time. They will begin this coming June.

The present plan (in 6 or 7 different phases) calls for the establishment of approximately 20 new collaboratives each year until the entire Archdiocese is participating. It is a plan to enable the Archdiocese to staff parishes and concentrate on the mission of the church.

At this time we have not heard anything from the Planning Office about the implementation of the Saint Peter / Saint John collaborative. So, obviously the earliest this could happen is in Phase Three – June of 2015. Of course it could also be at a later date. As things progress, I certainly will keep you apprised. For a complete look at this process and the parishes involved presently go to: disciplesinmission.org In the meantime, we continue to strengthen our parish by focusing on the celebration of the Eucharist. We also are expanding our opportunities of Faith Formation and introducing more opportunities for parishioners to reach out to each other and the wider community. Thus, centered on and nourished in the Eucharist we respond to the Gospel imperative to live our faith in such a way as to make Christ present in both our words and actions.

Vespers, Adoration, and Benediction will be celebrated on the third Wednesday of each month, from 7:00-8:00 PM, in the church. The service will begin (7:00-7:30) with the day's Evening Prayer from the Church's Liturgy of the Hours, including a Scripture reading and a brief homily. From 7:00-7:50 the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for silent Adoration, followed by Benediction. No experience with these forms of prayer is needed: full worship aides will be provided. Deacon Tim O'Donnell will lead the service. Please join us for this prayerful time to be with the Lord.

Still Time to Register for Grades K-10

Scripture Study

Parables of the Kingdom

“Do you not understand this parable?” (MK 4:13) is the question Jesus posed to his disciples. Just as the first disciples often did not understand Jesus’ many parables, so it is for listeners and readers nearly two thousand years later.” (From *Parables of the Kingdom*)

The parables offer us a glimpse into the kingdom of God and allow us the opportunity to think in new ways. Plan to join us this fall as we begin a yearlong, two-part study of the parables. We will begin this fall for a six week study of the parables in Mark and also found in Matthew. This coming Lent we will spend time studying the parables unique to Matthew and those developed in Luke. The Fall and Lent programs are independent, and **no previous scripture study experience is needed – all are truly welcome.**

We will use materials from the Little Rock Scripture Study program. The study will meet on Wednesdays, October 30, November 6, November 13, November 20, December 4, and December 11, 7-8:30 p.m. in the Parish Center.
