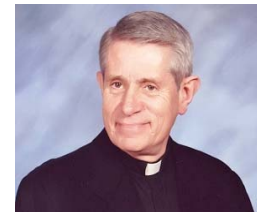

By now, many of you have probably taken down your trees, packed away your decorations, and put Christmas behind you (perhaps with a sigh of relief). But, as you can see from our beautifully decorated church, the Christmas Liturgical Season is still going strong. We celebrate the season from December 24th until the Baptism of the Lord, which is always the Sunday following Epiphany (today). The following Monday is the first day in Ordinary Time. This does not refer to mundane or boring, but simply a time that is not in one of our major liturgical seasons. It comes from the word "ordinal," which, as you'll remember from your math lessons, refers to rank (1st, 2nd, 3rd . . .). So we are still celebrating Christmas—and happily displaying in our bulletin the delightful art work of our parish school children. Many thanks to all who shared their art with us!
