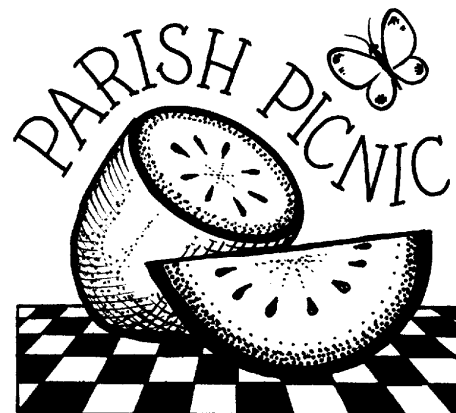

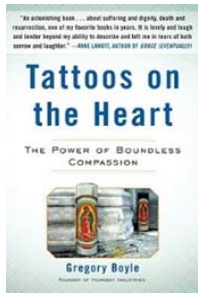

Summer Book and Movie Discussion



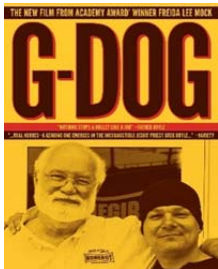
Are you looking for a compelling read this summer? Join us this summer as we read *Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion* by Gregory Boyle, SJ.

Book Description:

*“For twenty years, Gregory Boyle has run Homeboy Industries, a gang-intervention program located in the Boyle Heights neighborhood of Los Angeles, the gang capital of the world. In *Tattoos on the Heart*, he distills his experience working in the ghetto into a breathtaking series of parables inspired by faith.*

Arranged by theme and filled with sparkling humor and glowing generosity, these essays offer a stirring look at how full our lives could be if we could find the joy in loving others and in being loved unconditionally. From giant, tattooed Cesar, shopping at JC Penney fresh out of prison, we learn how to feel worthy of God's love. From ten-year-old Lula we learn the importance of being known and acknowledged. From Pedro we understand the kind of patience necessary to rescue someone from the darkness. In each chapter we benefit from Boyle's gentle, hard-earned wisdom.

*These essays about universal kinship and redemption are moving examples of the power of unconditional love and the importance of fighting despair. Gorgeous and uplifting, *Tattoos on the Heart* reminds us that no life is less valuable than another.”*



Father Boyle's work with Homeboy Industries was documented in a newly released film *G-Dog* by Oscar®-winning filmmaker Freida Lee Mock. We will view this film for the second part of this discussion series.

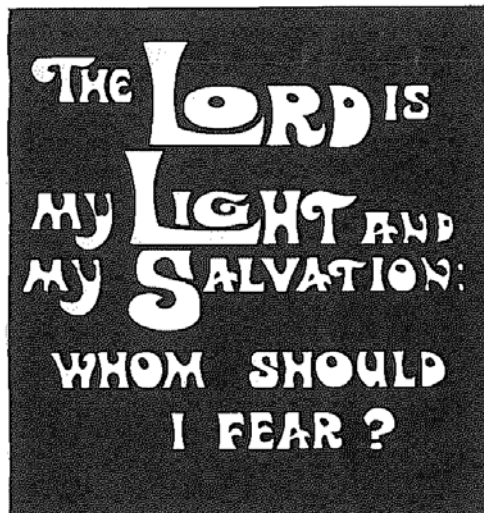
