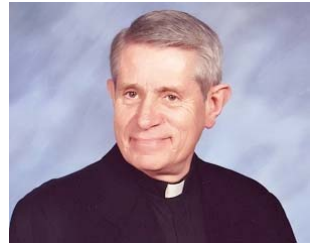

## FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

I thought that this week, I would give you an update on Pastoral Planning. As you know, Phase II of Pastoral Planning will begin in June of this year. That will bring the number of active collaboratives (separate parishes served by one pastoral team) to 33. There is on-going training happening for Phase I parishes, and now that pastors have been announced for Phase II groups, training will begin shortly. Phase III parishes will be announced in September of 2014.



At this time we don't know in which phase Saint Peter and Saint John Parishes will begin as a collaborative. As a long-range preparation I am happy to tell you that this coming Wednesday the leadership teams (staff, pastoral and finance councils) of both our parishes will meet. This is for a kind of "meet and greet" gathering – to say hello and explain a little about who we are and what our parishes are presently doing. A second gathering will take place in the spring. It is our hope that these meetings will be helpful in sharing information and alleviating some anxieties over the future. 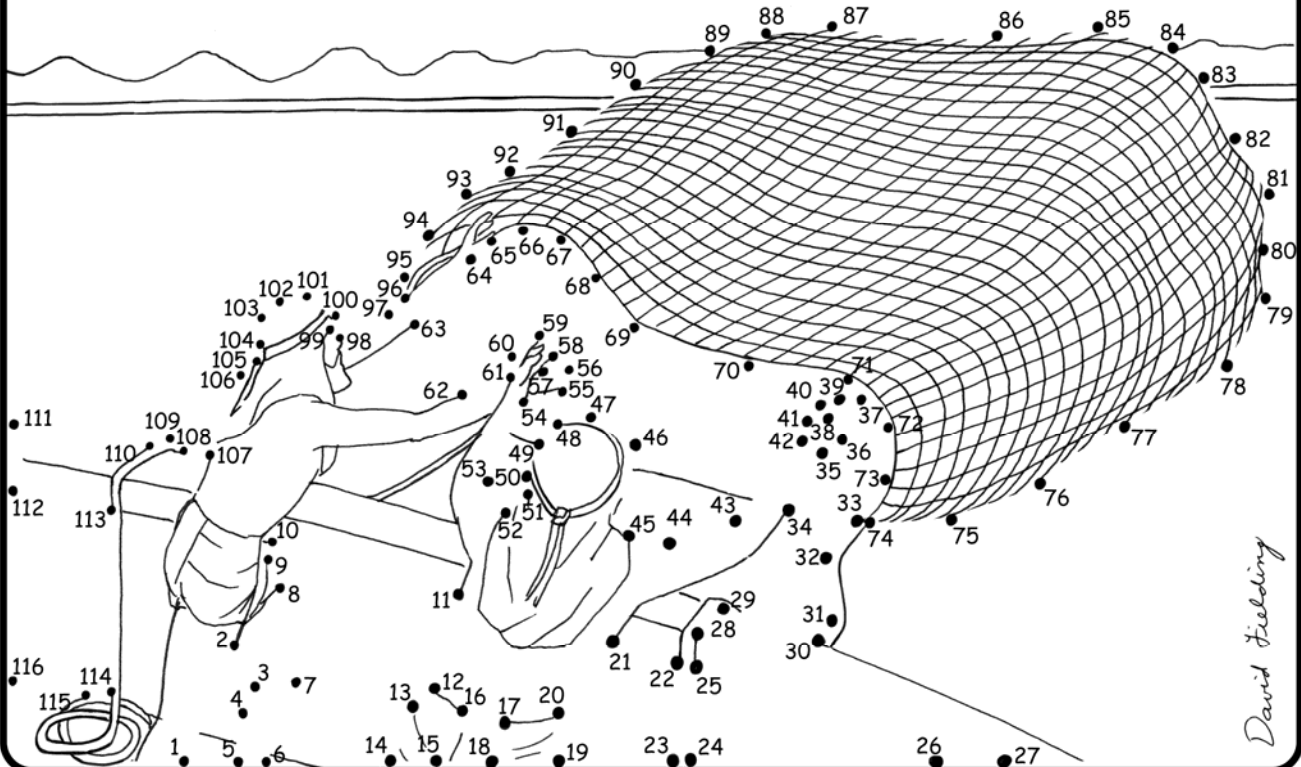
