**Small Faith Sharing Groups at St. Peter Parish**

Did you know that there are presently two on-going small faith groups that meet monthly at St. Peter Parish?

*What are small faith sharing groups?*

Small faith sharing groups gather to pray, reflect on scripture and share faith with other members of the group. Ideally, these groups have between 6-10 participants which meet monthly. These groups foster a sense of community both within the group and in the larger parish. A typical meeting is about an hour and a half and includes prayer and discussion.

One of our groups started after the parish *ARISE* program, the other started after the *Why Catholic?* program. Participation in this type of group allows one the ability to reflect on where they see God working in their lives; the opportunity to get to know other people in the parish; and the occasion to pray for and with others.

Do you think you may be interested in this type of opportunity? We are currently looking into establishing a third small faith sharing group this winter at St. Peter's. 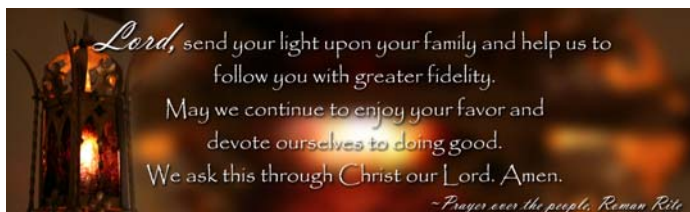

The Harvard Square Churches Meal Program began in 1982 as an ecumenical ministry in Harvard Square. It serves a nutritious sit down dinner every Thursday night at Christ Church to over 120 people each week. It takes many dedicated volunteers and donations to provide a healthy meal each week.
