FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Graduations and the closing of the School Year (this past week) mark another "Rite of Passage" for our School (established 1901) and Parish (established 1848). At the same time we are saddened to say good-bye to students, some faculty members and our long time Director of Advancement, but also energized by the possibilities and opportunities ahead of us.

It is an enormous blessing for Saint Peter Parish to still be able to host the last Catholic Grammar School in Cambridge. The School brings life and energy to the parish, and the parish brings almost a century and three-quarters of living faith experience to share with our students. What a privilege and challenge it is that has been given to us.

We are grateful to all the wonderful people – past and present – who have contributed to the vibrant faith life of our parish and school. We pray that Saint Peter continue to be that "Light On The Hill" – that beacon of faith and hope – for many, many years to come!!

PLEASE NOTE VERY IMPORTANT !!!

Just when you think everything is all set, something happens. We all know the feeling. This is kind of like what happened to some of our summer planning.

We knew that Fr. Jim Keenan was going to be away a good part of the summer and then going on sabbatical in the Fall. Plans for coverage were in the works. Then we were surprised when Fr. Christopher Frechette discovered that he would be on sabbatical for the coming year. Back to the drawing board.

Fr. Keenan and I sat down to see what we could do. Due to many factors, including Jesuits being away on other projects, our options were not as numerous as we would have hoped.

So our solution is this: Fr. Keenan will preside at the Sunday 5:00 PM liturgy for the first four weeks of June, and Fr. O'Malley will preside at that liturgy on Sunday, June 30th. **There will be no Sunday 5:00 PM liturgy from Sunday, July 7th through the Labor Day weekend.** On the weekend of September 7/8, 2013 the regular, full mass schedule of the parish resumes. (Saturday, 4:00 PM, Sunday 8:00 and 10:00 AM, 12:00 Noon, and 5:00 PM.) Please know that full coverage of the Sunday 5:00 PM liturgy for the Fall has already been arranged.

We are sorry for any inconvenience this causes, but it is the best that we can do at this time. Thank you for your understanding.

We have had a positive response for our summer outreach to the Harvard Square Churches Meal Program (Christ Church, 0 Garden Street). Beginning on June 20th and continuing through the summer on every Thursday evening (except July 4th) we will be assisting with serving a sit down dinner to the programs 120 guests. We will meet at St. Peter’s at 5pm (we can park here and walk down). Their doors open for guests at 5:30 and dinner is served at 6 pm. Clean up is 7-7:30.

Here are a few questions that have come up:

Q: Can my family go together?

A: Yes, it is a wonderful family activity for school age children.

Q: Can I meet you there?

A: Yes, not a problem. If you can let us know that would be great.

Q: I won’t know until mid-week if I can join you is that ok?

A: Absolutely, email Anna by Thursday morning.

This commitment can be once, once a month, every week – you decide. We ask that you let us know you are coming so we know how many to expect.
