



Talk by Daniel P. Horan, O.F.M., Wednesday, October 22, 7-8:30 p.m.: “St. Francis of Assisi: His Life, Legacy and Relevance for Today”

St. Francis of Assisi, one of the most popular saints, has received renewed attention after Pope Francis took his name. This presentation offers a deeper insight – going beyond the popular stories and legends – into St. Francis’s life and context, providing a richer understanding of his world while also highlighting his relevance for today.



Scripture Study: Book of Isaiah Begins October 29th

Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer, you shall cry for help, and he will say: "Here I am!"

Isaiah 58:9

Some of the most hopeful images we have in Scripture come from the Book of Isaiah. Join us as we learn about our ancestors in faith, their struggles, hopes and vision for the future. We will begin this fall for a seven week study of the first part of the Book of Isaiah. This coming Lent we will complete the study in a six week study. **No previous scripture study experience is needed – all are truly welcome.** We will use materials from the Little Rock Scripture Study program (a reader and a study guide) and a Bible. There is a reading assignment and reflection questions each week. We will spend our time together discussing Scripture, the discussion questions and listening to an audio lecture. The study will meet on Wednesdays, 7-8:30 p.m. in the Parish Center, October 29 – December 17 (no meeting on November 26).
