From the Pastor's Desk


Hard to believe – but here we are at the last weekend of the summer season! (Why won't February disappear as fast as July and August seem to??)



Religious Education Grades K - 10

1st Eucharist, Reconciliation and Confirmation

The primary place where children learn about and experience their faith is in their homes. Their primary educators are their parents and adult caretakers. Our education program is designed as a shared undertaking between children, parents, and the parish. We offer educational programs for grades K - 10 and to prepare children to receive the Sacraments of Eucharist, Reconciliation and Confirmation. Children traditionally receive Eucharist and Reconciliation in Grade 2 and Confirmation in Grade 10. We also prepare children beyond these ages. Grades K - 5 meet Sunday mornings from 10:15 - 11:15 a.m., beginning September 28th.
