







Discussion With Sister Mary Owens of Dublin and Nairobi About Programs to Care for Children Affected by HIV/AIDS

Sister Mary Owens, of the Sisters of Loreto, is the Executive Director of *Nyumbani*, a group of programs founded in 1992 in Kenya. It consists of an orphanage for 100 children, a sustainable ecological village for 1,000 children, clinics for 3,000 children in Nairobi, and a specialized diagnostic laboratory for HIV/AIDS therapy monitoring. This past summer students, alumni and professors of Regis College visited Nyumbani to perform vision screening on the children and the staff that cares for them. Scripture Study: Book of Isaiah Begins October 29th

Then you shall call, and the Lord will answer, you shall cry for help, and he will say: "Here I am!"

Some of the most hopeful images we have in Scripture come from the Book of Isaiah. Join us as we learn about our ancestors in faith, their struggles, hopes and vision for the future. We will begin this fall for a seven week study of the first part of the Book of Isaiah. This coming Lent we will complete the study in a six week study. **No previous scripture study experience is needed – all are truly welcome.** We will use materials from the Little Rock Scripture Study program (a reader and a study guide) and a Bible. There is a reading assignment and reflection questions each week. We will spend our time together discussing Scripture, the discussion questions and listening to an audio lecture. The study will meet on Wednesdays, 7-8:30 p.m. in the Parish Center, October 29 – December 17 (no meeting on November 26).
