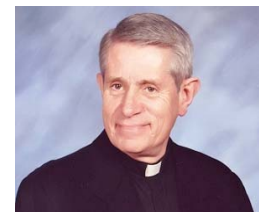

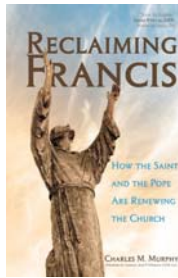

Sister Mary Owens, of the Sisters of Loreto, is the Executive Director of *Nyumbani*, a group of programs founded in 1992 in Kenya. It consists of an orphanage for 100 children, a sustainable ecological village for 1,000 children, clinics for 3,000 children in Nairobi, and a specialized diagnostic laboratory for HIV/AIDS therapy monitoring. This past summer students, alumni and professors of Regis College visited Nyumbani to perform vision screening on the children and the staff that cares for them. 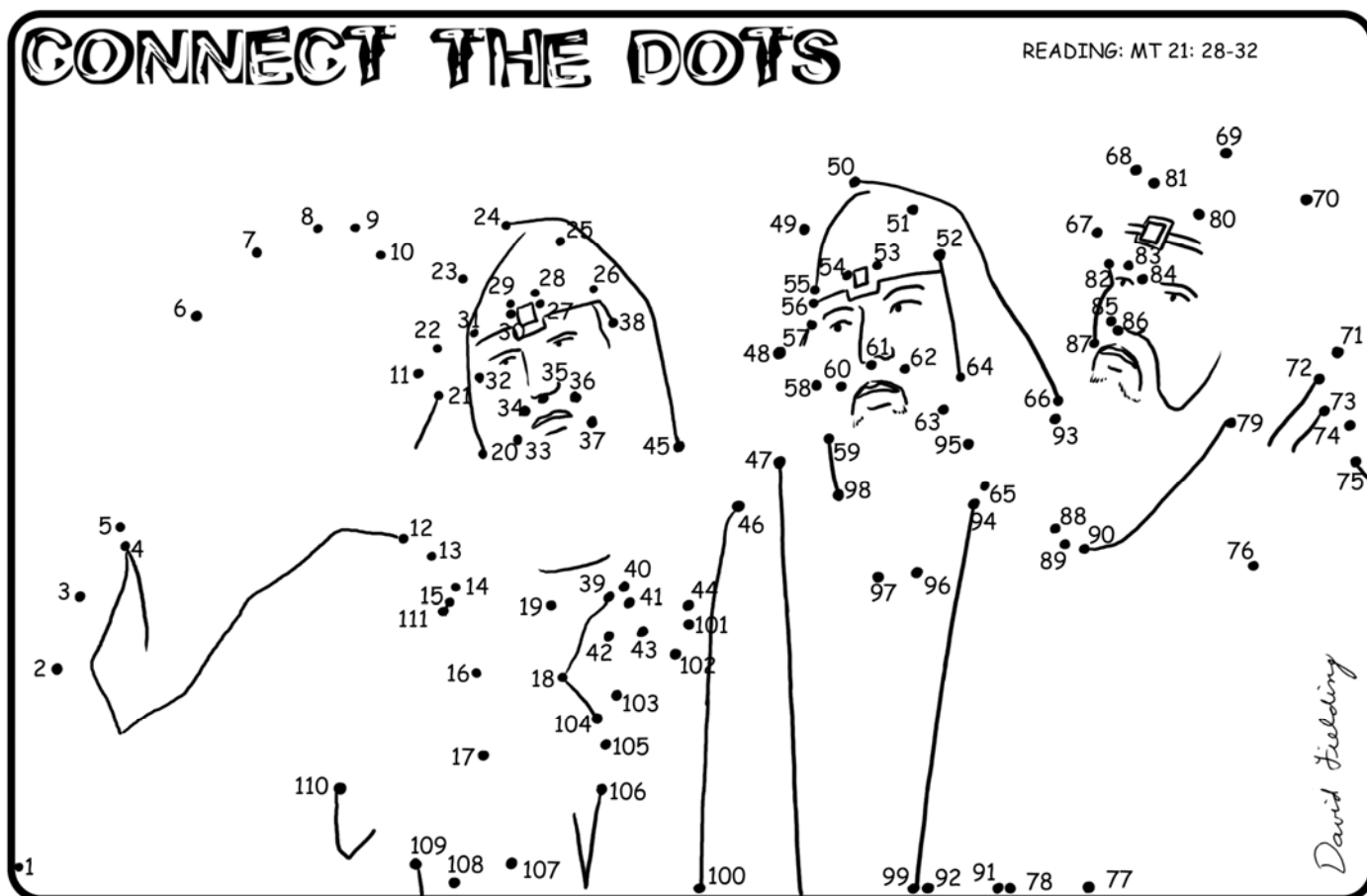
