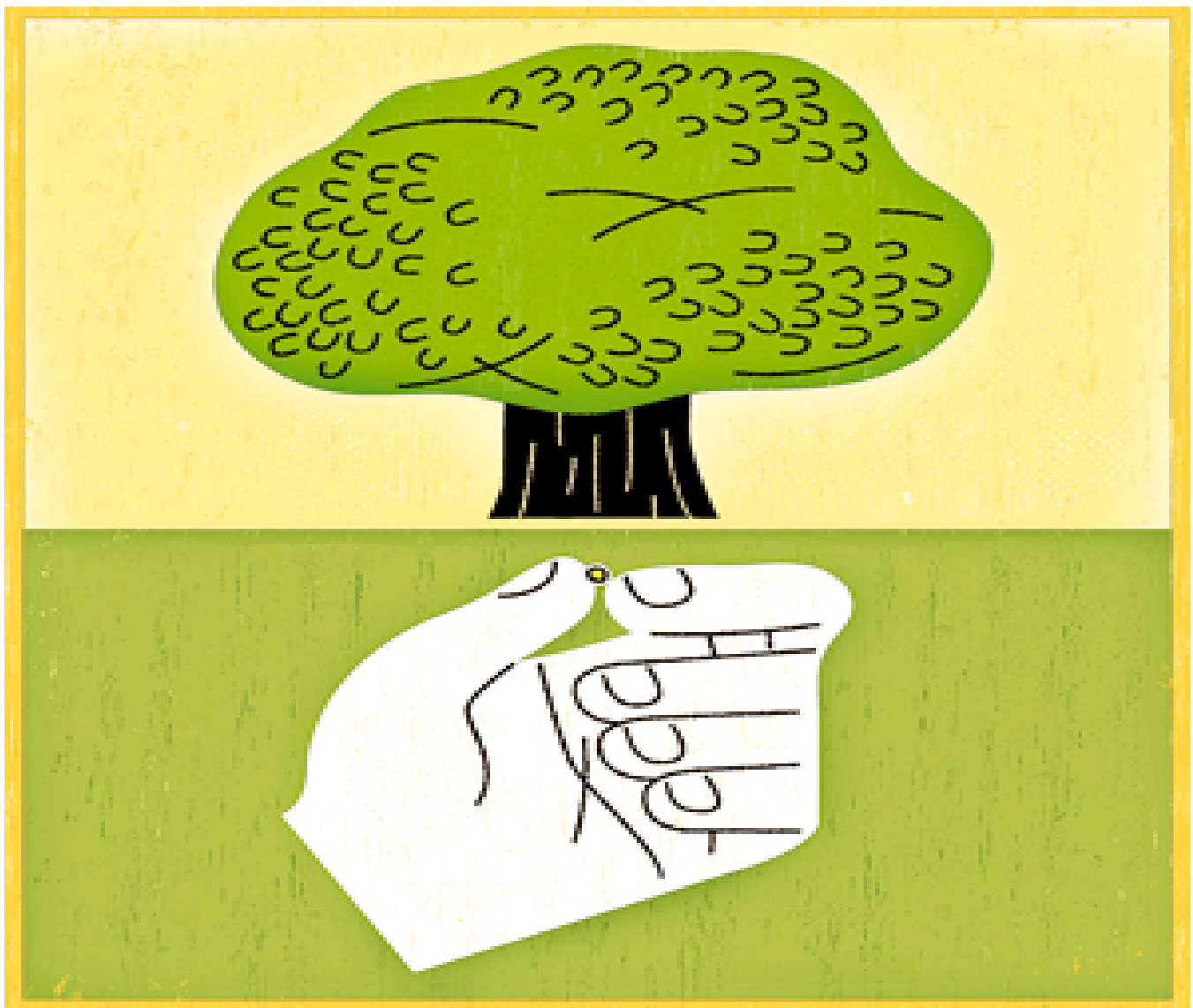

**FROM THE PASTOR’S DESK:**

Last weekend someone asked me about this year’s Grand Annual Collection.

As you know, last Fall we did an *Increased Offertory* Campaign. I welcomed the opportunity to speak with the congregation about parish expenses, and the need to change the way we finance our parish life. At that time we asked people to carefully and prayerfully consider what each offered over the course of the year and, if possible, make an increase to that amount. Purposely we have tried to severely limit second collections. And, as you know, the collection basket is never passed more than once at weekend masses. We also let people know that the parish has the availability of *Online Giving*. People responded very thoughtfully and generously to our appeal. Thank you again. Certainly we hope new parishioners will give generously according to their means as well.

While we have not planned a formal *Grand Annual* collection for this month, we would never discourage those who prefer to make a larger donation at this time of year. Any – and all – gifts are graciously received and put to good use. Other parishioners may prefer to make smaller gifts over the course of the year, and those are most welcome as well.

A full financial accounting is now being prepared for both last year’s activities and projected budgets for this year. We will let you know when they are available. Thank you.

Matignon High School in Cambridge, MA is offering a prep course this October for the High School Placement Test. This course is open to any 8<sup>th</sup> grade public or parochial school student in the area interested in preparing for the Catholic High School Placement Test. Students review test-taking strategies, sample questions and timed practice tests from highly qualified SAT instructors. #### Scripture Study – Parables of the Kingdom

*“Do you not understand this parable?” (MK 4:13) is the question Jesus posed to his disciples. Just as the first disciples often did not understand Jesus’ many parables, so it is for listeners and readers nearly two thousand years later.” (from *Parables of the Kingdom*)*

The parables offer us a glimpse into the kingdom of God and allow us the opportunity to think in new ways. Plan to join us this fall as we begin a yearlong two part study of the parables. We will begin this fall for a six week study of the parables in Mark and also found in Matthew. This coming Lent we will spend time studying the parables unique to Matthew and those developed in Luke. The Fall and Lent programs are independent, and **no previous scripture study experience is needed – all are truly welcome**. We will use materials from the Little Rock Scripture Study program. The study will meet on Wednesdays October 30, November 6, November 13, November 20, December 4, and December 11<sup>th</sup>, 7-8:30 p.m. in the Parish Center.
